Welfare Program for Old Age Home

Through a Welfare Program for Old Age Home by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti , a day full of fun activities that promoted happiness and inclusiveness was organized. Performances such as music, dance or poetry recitation were arranged, giving residents a chance to showcase their talents and enjoy professional entertainment. Nutritious meals and snacks were provided throughout the day, including traditional dishes. Interactive games and workshops were included that encouraged participation and social interaction. At the end, residents were given small gifts or tokens of appreciation, making them feel valued and cherished. The event was documented through photos and videos to create lasting memories.

Environmental Awareness Program

Environmental awareness programs were organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti in several areas of Gonda district. Tree plantation drives were organized in local parks and community areas, where families and individuals were encouraged to participate. Educational material on recycling, conservation and eco-friendly habits were provided to be distributed during the program. A cleanliness drive was included, where volunteers gathered to clean up litter in parks, streets and riverbanks. The program concluded with a cultural performance that highlighted the importance of environmental conservation.

Health Awareness Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti conducted a health awareness program in several areas of Gonda district by conducting free health check-ups, distributing informative pamphlets and organizing interactive sessions on hygiene, nutrition and preventive healthcare. The program involved community participation, emphasizing the importance of healthy lifestyles and regular medical check-ups, especially for disadvantaged groups. Volunteers and medical professionals provided advice and support, helping to raise awareness about common health problems and available treatments.

Consumer Awareness Program

The consumer awareness program organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti focused on educating the community about consumer rights and responsibilities. Activities included workshops on identifying counterfeit products, understanding labeling and warranties, and navigating consumer complaint processes. Informative pamphlets were distributed to highlight key consumer laws and protection mechanisms. Interactive sessions encouraged participants to share experiences and ask questions, thereby promoting a culture of informed consumption. The program aimed to empower individuals to make better choices and advocate for their rights in the market place.

Education & Literacy Program

The education and literacy program was organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti in various areas of Gonda district. The program included setting up free learning centres, distributing educational material and conducting workshops for basic literacy, math and digital skills. Volunteers conducted tutoring sessions for children and adults, with a focus on those who did not have formal education. Additionally, the awareness campaign highlighted the importance of education for personal and community development. The initiative aimed to empower individuals through knowledge, helping them improve their quality of life and future opportunities.

Computer Training/Coaching Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti provided basic computer education to youth and adults from underprivileged communities through a computer training/coaching program. The program provided practical training in essential computer skills such as operating systems, typing, MS Office and internet browsing. Participants were also introduced to online resources for learning and job opportunities. The workshops emphasized the importance of digital literacy in today's job market, helping learners become more confident and self-reliant in using technology.

Handicrafts Training & Production Center

The Handicraft Training and Production Centre by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti aim to empower local artisans and unemployed individuals by providing skill-based training in traditional and modern handicrafts. The program offered workshops on craft techniques, design innovation and product development covering items such as embroidery, weaving, pottery and jewellery making. Participants received practical experience and guidance from skilled artisans, enabling them to create marketable products. The program promoted self-reliance and preserved cultural heritage through sustainable handicraft production.

Skill Development Training Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti organized a skill development training program by organizing workshops, providing practical training and encouraging participation in practical sessions. The program focused on enhancing employability, showcasing success stories of past trainees and distributing certificates to participants. The program encouraged community participation, focused on skill building in areas such as tailoring, computer literacy and vocational trades to promote self-reliance and economic empowerment.

Rural & Agricultural Development Program

Rural and agricultural development programs were organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti in several areas of Gonda district. The program focused on improving rural livelihoods by introducing modern farming techniques, promoting sustainable agricultural practices and providing farmers access to essential resources such as quality seeds, fertilizers and training. The program encourages water conservation,

organic farming and the use of eco-friendly methods to increase productivity. It also organized workshops on animal husbandry, crop rotation and financial literacy, helping farmers become more self-reliant and resilient to market fluctuations.

Drinking Water & Sanitation Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti conducted a drinking water and sanitation program in several areas of Gonda district with the aim of ensuring access to safe drinking water and promoting proper sanitation practices in rural communities. The initiative involved constructing and maintaining clean water supply systems, installing hand pumps and providing water purification education. Additionally, the program focused on building sanitation facilities such as toilets to improve hygiene and reduce health risks. Community awareness campaigns were conducted to educate residents about the importance of hygiene, safe water use and prevention of waterborne diseases, ultimately improving the overall health and well-being of the community.

Drug De - Addiction Program

The de-addiction program by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti was organized in several areas of Gonda district through various community engagement activities. These included holding awareness rallies, distributing informational pamphlets and conducting workshops on the dangers of substance abuse. Former addicts shared their stories to inspire others, and counselors provided guidance to individuals seeking help. Medical check-ups and de-addiction counseling were available on site. Cultural programs such as street plays and songs with anti-addiction messages created awareness in an engaging manner.

Child Labor Care Program

The Child Labor Care Program was organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti in several areas of Gonda district by conducting awareness campaigns, community workshops and street plays that highlighted the harmful effects of child labor. Collaborations were made with local schools to enroll rescued children, provide educational support and vocational training to families. The program included distribution of educational material, health check-ups and counseling for affected families, aimed at rehabilitating and empowering the children for a better future.

Annual Cultural Program

The annual cultural event by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti was celebrated with live performances of local art, dance and music. The event included traditional and contemporary cultural performances by members of the community, especially children and youth. There was an exhibition of local handicrafts, storytelling sessions and competitions in art, music and dance. Prizes were given to all after the competitions. The event concluded with the serving of light and nutritious refreshments. The aim of the event is to promote cultural heritage, foster unity and raise awareness about social issues through creative expression.

Youth & Adolescent Welfare Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti organized a youth and adolescent welfare program in Gonda district by conducting workshops on life skills, health awareness and career guidance. Sports events, talent shows and leadership training sessions were organized to empower the youth. Seminars on mental health, substance abuse prevention and gender sensitization were organized, as well as interactive sessions with motivational speakers. The program promotes education, personal development and social responsibility among the youth.

Handicapped Welfare Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti organized Handicapped Welfare Program through health camps that provided free medical check-ups and rehabilitation services. Assistive devices such as wheelchairs and hearing aids were provided and awareness campaigns were conducted to promote inclusiveness. The program included vocational training and skill development workshops to empower persons with disabilities, as well as cultural programs that showcased their talents. Support groups and counseling services were also provided to promote community and enhance the quality of life of participants.

Rain Water Harvesting/ Recharging Program

The rainwater harvesting/recharging program was organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti by conducting community workshops to educate residents about the importance of rainwater harvesting. Demonstrations on the construction of

rainwater harvesting systems were hosted involving local artisans and experts. Clean-up drives were conducted to prepare collection areas for the upcoming rains and households were encouraged to participate in the construction and maintenance of rainwater harvesting systems. The program concluded with a community gathering to share experiences and highlight the importance of sustainable water management.

SC, ST, & Minority Welfare Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti organized SC, ST and Minority welfare programs in several areas of Gonda district through awareness campaigns highlighting the importance of inclusiveness and support for marginalized communities. Workshops and seminars were organized, focusing on skill development, educational opportunities and government schemes available for these groups. Local leaders and experts were invited to share insights and experiences. Cultural programs were organized showcasing the rich heritage of SC, ST and minority communities, promoting unity and respect.

Water Quality Management Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti conducted a water quality management program in several areas of Gonda district. Workshops were held to educate residents on water testing methods and proper hygiene practices. Collaborate with local health experts to discuss waterborne diseases and preventive measures. A water testing center was set up where community members could bring samples for analysis. Informational material on water purification methods was distributed and households were encouraged to adopt safe practices. Concluded with a community meeting to share findings, collect feedback, and discuss future water quality improvement initiatives.

Tobacco Awareness Program

Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti conducted tobacco awareness programs in several areas of Gonda district to educate the community about the health risks of tobacco use. Local health experts were invited to talk about the dangers and provide resources for quitting. Awareness booths were set up in public places with informative brochures and materials. Youth were engaged through art competitions and plays that

conveyed anti-tobacco messages. Collaborate with local schools to incorporate anti-tobacco education into their curriculum. A rally was organized to promote a smoke-free environment, which encouraged community participation.

Road Safety Awareness Program

Road safety awareness programs were organized by Jan Utthan Sewa Samiti in several areas of Gonda district to educate the community about traffic rules and safe driving practices. Pamphlets and flyers with key road safety messages were distributed. Interactive sessions were held with the local traffic police to discuss real-life scenarios and safety tips. Road safety displays were set up in public areas to demonstrate the importance of wearing helmets and seatbelts. Community rallies were organized to promote safe road behavior and encourage participation from all age groups.
